

## PALOUSE AUDUBON SOCIETY CHRISTMAS BIRD COUNT CHECKLIST

The following list includes all species previously identified on a Christmas Bird Count in our area. The symbols following each species have the following meanings: (A) ABUNDANT - seen nearly every year in large numbers. (C) COMMON - seen nearly every year in fairly large numbers. (U) UNCOMMON - seen only in small numbers and/or not seen most years. (R) RARE - Seen on few counts and only in small numbers.

**\*These species are so unusual for this area that a reported sighting will have to be documented to National Audubon Society by the Observer(s). (This would also apply to most bird species not on the list.) We do know that other species do exist in the area; so watch for them.**
